



Thank you for your application to EEF's Focus on Vision program for in-need TUSD students. Please follow the instructions below in order for the student to receive his/her eyeglasses in a timely manner.

1. Call 325.8688 immediately to make an appointment to come into EEF's office this week of this notification in order to pick up a One Sight Voucher (for LensCrafters frame and lenses) and an EEF voucher (for the eye exam at LensCrafters). EEF's office is open M-F 9am to 5pm and is located on the Second Street side of St. Mark's Church in the 3800 block of Second Street. Please do not stop by without first calling.
2. As soon as you have picked up these vouchers, contact LensCrafters at Park Mall (747-4040) or on North Oracle Road, across the street from Tucson Mall (888-0440) to schedule an exam and fitting. The student's appointment at LensCrafters must occur within 30 days of the date of issuance of EEF vouchers.
3. Accompany the student to the LensCrafters location where s/he has an eye exam appointment and select a pair of eyeglass frames with the student from LensCrafters' \$99.95 section.
4. Present EEF issued One Sight voucher to a LensCrafters employee as payment for the frame and lenses.
5. Present the EEF issued EEF FOV voucher to a LensCrafters employee as payment for the eye exam.
6. Pick up eyeglasses as instructed by LensCrafters.

Please NOTE the expiration date on the voucher issued by EEF for student. Vouchers are not transferable, cannot be replaced, and are time sensitive. In the rare case that it is determined that a student does not need eyeglasses, please return the unused vouchers to EEF.
