Re: New Application Form and Process for EEF Interscholastic Scholarships 2010-2011

Welcome to 2010-2011 school year. **Please note that EEF has made some changes to its application form and process for EEF Interscholastic Scholarships.** Similar to the application process for EEF's other Special Needs Fund programs, the Interscholastic Scholarship application form now needs to be filled out by the student, parent and the appropriate TUSD representative and submitted directly to EEF.

When completing and submitting the form (after the student has completed his/her portion) the principal, assistant principal, head counselor, OR interscholastic coordinator now needs to also clearly verify via his/her signature that the student is eligible for free/reduced lunch BEFORE submitting the completed form to EEF (TUSD Food Services department can help with the USDA guidelines free/reduced lunch eligibility).

Please submit all completed, verified, and signed applications via fax, interschool mail or regular mail to the EEF office.
