

Focus on Vision Program Instructions

1. Identify student need for glasses. Students without vision insurance or the ability to obtain new prescription glasses despite having insurance will qualify.
 - a. Parent/Guardian: Fill out the application and return it to TUSD staff for authorization.
 - b. TUSD staff: Submit the completed & authorized application to programs@eefucson.org.
2. Please allow 5 business days for processing. Once approved, TUSD staff will receive an email with these instructions, the voucher (time sensitive), and the medical paperwork to be completed by the parent/guardian. If denied, EEF will also notify TUSD staff.
3. The voucher and paperwork must be printed out to take to the appointment. **A TUSD REPRESENTATIVE MUST SIGN THE VOUCHER.**
4. Call Nationwide Vision (locations participating in the program below) to schedule an exam or glasses fitting. The student's appointment must occur within 45 days of the date of voucher issuance.
5. Parents/guardians or TUSD staff are permitted to transport students to and from the appointment. Whoever transports the student to the appointment will present the signed voucher and paperwork to the Nationwide staff at the appointment.
6. The TUSD representative or parent/guardian accompanying the student will help with selecting a pair of eyeglass frames from the designated section (frames up to \$109.99 value).
7. The glasses will be ready within 1-2 weeks after the appointment. Once the glasses are ready Nationwide will contact the school representative or parent based on the phone number listed on the paperwork completed at the appointment. Upon notification that the glasses are ready, the TUSD representative or parent/guardian can pick up the glasses and the student may be fitted at the same time.

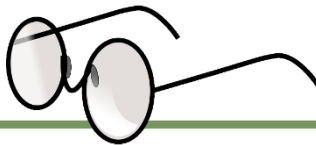
